This letter is to invite you and your designees to a tribal consultation meeting to discuss the planning and establishment of New York's Health Benefit Exchange. The meeting will be held from 1 pm to 4 pm on October 30, 2012 in Syracuse, New York.

New York is developing a state-based Exchange pursuant to the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). The Exchange will offer affordable health insurance through qualified health plans to individuals and small businesses. It will provide a consumer friendly application and assistance to facilitate plan enrollment and determinations for premium and cost-sharing subsidies.

The ACA provides important benefits to members of federally recognized tribes. Tribal members are not subject to penalties for not enrolling in health insurance coverage. In addition, tribal members who do enroll in health insurance coverage through the Exchange will have lower cost-sharing and will be allowed to enroll in qualified health plans on a monthly basis. The Exchange would like to work with you to ensure that systems are in place so that these benefits are easily attainable by tribal members.
