


More than 4 million New Yorkers get their health insurance through NY State of Health, the state's official health plan Marketplace, including 218,851 in the Mid-Hudson Region (Delaware, Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Sullivan, and Ulster counties).

All Marketplace plans offer comprehensive coverage including, but not limited to:

- Free Preventive Services
- Doctor visits, including specialists
- Tests ordered by your doctor
- Prescription drugs
- Inpatient and outpatient care at a hospital

HERE ARE THE FACTS

FACT 1: THE UNINSURED RATE IN THE MID-HUDSON REGION DECLINED FROM 9.0% TO 4.9% BETWEEN 2013 AND 2016. NEARLY 42,000 RESIDENTS GAINED COVERAGE DURING THIS PERIOD.

*The "Amount You Pay" for Qualified Health Plans reflects the cost of the most popular silver plan after applying tax credits. Tax credit amounts vary by income; at \$48,241 individuals are no longer eligible for tax credits and will pay the full QHP premium. Bronze level coverage is available for free in most counties in this region for individuals earning \$25,000. Note that QHP premiums may vary by county within the region. Costs shown here are for eligible individuals.
