NOTICE OF DISMISSAL – FAILURE TO APPEAR

Dear [REDACTED],

On December 6, 2015, the Marketplace issued an enrollment notice confirming your enrollment in a Medicaid Managed Care (MMC) plan, effective January 1, 2016. You appealed the enrollment start date of your MMC plan insofar as you wanted it to start December 1, 2015.

On January 15, 2016, the Marketplace issued a Notice of Hearing to advise you that the hearing you requested was scheduled for February 16, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.

On February 16, 2016, a Hearing Officer placed three calls to the telephone number that you provided to the Marketplace, at 10:00 a.m., 10:05 a.m., and 10:30 a.m., but was unable to reach you.

Since you did not appear for your hearing as scheduled, your appeal was dismissed and a notice of dismissal was issued to this effect on February 19, 2016.

On March 7, 2016, the Marketplace received your undated written request to vacate, or cancel, the dismissal, which was granted.

On March 11, 2016, the Marketplace issued a Notice of Hearing to advise you that the rescheduled hearing you requested was scheduled for April 11, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.

On April 11, 2016, a Hearing officer placed three calls to the telephone number that you had provided to the Marketplace, at 10:00 a.m., 10:05 a.m., and 10:30 a.m., but was unable to reach you.

Since you did not appear for your hearing as rescheduled, we are dismissing your appeal.

How does this Dismissal Affect My Eligibility?

The Appeals Unit of NY State of Health will not review your appeal at this time.

If You Think Your Appeal Should Not Be Dismissed

If you think your appeal should not be dismissed, you can ask us to vacate (cancel) this dismissal. You must ask us, in writing, within 30 days after the date on this notice. In that writing, you must explain why you did not appear for your hearing as scheduled.

The Marketplace's Appeals Unit will review your request. If your request is approved, another hearing will be scheduled for you. If your request is denied, the Marketplace will tell you in writing.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days, your appeal will remain dismissed, and the Marketplace will take no further action on your appeal.
