## Issue

The issue presented for review by the Appeals Unit of NY State of Health is:

Did NY State of Health (NYSOH) properly determine that you were not eligible to receive Medicaid through NYSOH, as of August 2, 2017?

## Procedural History

On August 30, 2016, NYSOH issued an eligibility determination notice stating that you were eligible for Medicaid, effective August 1, 2016.

On June 3, 2017, NYSOH issued a renewal notice, stating that it was time to renew your health insurance. That notice stated that, based on information from federal and state sources, NYSOH could not make a decision about whether you would qualify for financial help paying for your health coverage, and that you needed to update your account between June 16, 2017 and July 15, 2017, or you might lose the financial assistance you were currently receiving.

On June 16, 2017, you updated your NYSOH application. That same day, NYSOH prepared a preliminary eligibility determination, stating that you were not eligible to purchase health coverage through NYSOH.

Also on June 16, 2017, you spoke with NYSOH's Account Review Unit and requested an appeal of that preliminary eligibility determination, as it related to your ineligibility for Medicaid.

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On June 17, 2017, NYSOH issued an eligibility determination notice stating that you are not eligible to enroll in coverage through NYSOH. This was because federal and state data sources showed that you are receiving Medicare, and individual receiving Medicare cannot receive health coverage through NYSOH. Your eligibility ended effective August 2, 2017.

On September 14, 2017, you had a telephone hearing with a Hearing Officer from NYSOH's Appeals Unit. During the hearing, your [REDACTED], [REDACTED], was sworn in as your Authorized Representative (AR), and she provided testimony on your behalf. The record was developed during the hearing and closed at the end of the hearing.

## Findings of Fact

A review of the record supports the following findings of fact:

- 1) You testified that you expect to file your 2017 taxes with a tax filing status of single. You will claim no dependents on that tax return.
- 2) Your AR testified that you were found eligible for, and enrolled, in Medicare Part B, as of July 1, 2017.
- 3) You testified, and the record reflects, that your date of birth is [REDACTED], and that you are currently [REDACTED].
- 4) Your AR testified that [REDACTED] does not think you have applied for Medicaid through your Local Department of Social Services (LDSS).
- 5) You testified that you live with your [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], but you are not the caretaker of any children under 18 years of age.
- 6) Your AR testified that you need Medicaid because your Medicare only covers your medical appointments and prescriptions, and does not cover dental or vision services, which you are in need of.
- 7) Your application states that you live in [REDACTED].

Conflicting evidence, if any, was considered and found to be less credible than the evidence noted above.

## **Applicable Law and Regulations**

### Medicaid

An individual is eligible for enrollment in Medicaid through NYSOH (called MAGI-based Medicaid) when he or she meets certain nonfinancial criteria and has a household income that is at or below the applicable Medicaid income standard (45 CFR § 155.305(c); N.Y. Soc. Serv. Law § 366(1)(b)).

In general, to qualify for MAGI-based Medicaid through NYSOH, you must also be one of the following:

- An adult aged 19-64 who is not eligible for Medicare Part A or Part B,
- A pregnant woman or infant,
- A child aged 1-18, or
- A parent or caretaker relative

(45 CFR § 155.305(c); N.Y. Soc. Serv. Law § 366(1)(b)).

If an individual does not fall into one of these categories, he or she may still be eligible for non-MAGI-based Medicaid coverage through their Local Department of Social Services or the New York City Human Resources Administration (see N.Y. Soc. Serv. Law § 366(1)(c)).

## **Legal Analysis**

The issue under review is whether NYSOH properly determined that you were not eligible to receive Medicaid through NYSOH.

Medicaid through NYSOH (called MAGI-based Medicaid) is available to individuals who are between the ages of 19 and 64, who are not eligible for Medicare Parts A or B; pregnant women or infants; children between the ages of 1 and 18; and parent or caretaker relatives.

According to your testimony and the information in your NYSOH application, you are single with no dependents and, therefore, you are not a parent or a caretaker relative of a dependent child.

The record reflects that, at the time NYSOH issued the June 18, 2017 eligibility determination you were [REDACTED], and were going to be eligible for Medicare as of July 1, 2017. NYSOH issued a notice of eligibility determination stating that your eligibility for coverage through NYSOH was therefore ending as of August 2, 2017.

Since you are currently receiving Medicare Part B, and are not a parent or caretaker relative of a child under 18 years old, NYSOH properly determined that you are not eligible for Medicaid through NYSOH.

However, individuals who are no longer eligible for MAGI-based Medicaid because they are receiving Medicare may qualify for Medicaid under non-MAGI standards. Non-MAGI Medicaid eligibility is determined by LDSS. If you wish to find out whether you are eligible for non-MAGI Medicaid, you must complete an application with your local Department of Social Services.

## **Decision**

The June 18, 2017 eligibility determination notice is AFFIRMED.

## **How this Decision Affects Your Eligibility**

You are not eligible for MAGI-based Medicaid through NYSOH because you are eligible for and enrolled in Medicare Part B.

You may apply for non-MAGI Medicaid through your local Department of Social Services, if you wish to find out whether you are eligible.

## **If You Disagree with this Decision (Appeal Rights)**

This Decision is final unless you submit an appeal request to the Federal Marketplace or bring a lawsuit under New York Civil Practice Law and Rules, Article 78.

You may bring a lawsuit on any Appeals Unit decision in New York State court in accordance with Article 78 of the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules. This must be done within four months of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision.

Additionally, Appeals Unit decisions on issues involving eligibility for qualified health plans, advance premium tax credits, and cost-sharing reductions may be appealed to the Federal Marketplace. This must be done within 30 days of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision (45 CFR § 155.520(c)).
