## lssue

The issue presented for review by the Appeals Unit of NY State of Health is:

Did NY State of Health (NYSOH) properly determine that you were eligible to receive up to \$175.00 per month in advance payments of the premium tax credit (APTC), ineligible for cost-sharing reductions, ineligible for the Essential Plan, and ineligible for Medicaid, all effective January 1, 2018?

# Procedural History

On December 2, 2017, you applied for health insurance and financial assistance through NYSOH. That day, a preliminary eligibility determination was prepared with respect to that application, stating that you were eligible to receive up to \$175.00 in APTC.

Also on December 2, 2017, you spoke to NYSOH's Account Review Unit and appealed that eligibility determination notice insofar as you were not eligible for an increased amount of financial assistance.

On December 3, 2017, NYSOH issued an eligibility determination notice stating that you were eligible to receive up to \$175.00 per month in APTC. That notice also stated that you were not eligible for cost-sharing reductions, the Essential Plan or Medicaid because your annual household income was over the allowable income limits for those programs.

Also on December 3, 2017, NYSOH issued an enrollment confirmation notice stating that you were enrolled in a qualified health plan with APTC, effective January 1, 2018.

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On February 6, 2018, you had a telephone hearing with a Hearing Officer from NYSOH's Appeals Unit. During the hearing Spanish Interpreter **Exercise** interpreted. The record was developed during the hearing and closed at the end of the hearing.

# **Findings of Fact**

A review of the record supports the following findings of fact:

- 1) You testified that you expect to file your tax return for 2018 with a tax filing status of single. You will claim one dependent on that tax return.
- 2) The application submitted on December 2, 3017 indicated that you were filing your 2018 tax return as single and not claiming any dependents.
- 3) The December 3, 2017 eligibility determination was based on a oneperson household. You testified at the hearing that you will be claiming your youngest son as a dependent on your 2018 tax return.
- 4) You are seeking insurance for yourself.
- 5) The application that was submitted on December 2, 2017 listed annual household income of \$41,995.20, consisting of \$41,995.20 you earn from your employment. You testified that this amount was correct.
- 6) Your application states that you will not be taking any deductions on your 2018 tax return.
- 7) Your application states that you live in Kings County.
- 8) You testified that you are seeking additional financial assistance through this appeal.

Conflicting evidence, if any, was considered and found to be less credible than the evidence noted above.

# Applicable Law and Regulations

## Advance Payments of Premium Tax Credit

APTC are generally available to a person who is eligible to enroll in a qualified health plan and (1) expects to have a household income between 138% and 400% of the applicable federal poverty level (FPL), (2) expects to file a tax return

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and claim a personal exemption deduction for a person who meets the eligibility requirements to enroll in a qualified health plan, and (3) is not otherwise eligible for minimum essential coverage except through the individual market (see 45 CFR § 155.305(f), 26 CFR § 1.36B-2, 42 CFR § 435.119(b), 42 CFR § 435.911(b)(1), 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4)).

People who use the APTC to help pay health insurance premiums must file a federal tax return and reconcile their expected income (stated on NYSOH application) with their actual income (stated on their federal income tax return). Those who take less tax credit in advance than they claim on the tax return may get the rest of it as an income tax refund or have their tax bill reduced. Those who take more tax credit in advance than they can claim on their tax return will owe the difference as additional income taxes (26 CFR § 1.36B-4).

## Cost-Sharing Reductions

Cost-sharing reductions are available to a person who (1) is eligible to enroll in a qualified health plan through NYSOH, (2) meets the requirements to receive APTC, (3) is expected to have an annual household income that does not exceed 250% of the FPL for the first day of the open enrollment period of the benefit year for which coverage is requested, and (4) is enrolled in a silver-level qualified health plan (45 CFR § 155.300(a), 45 CFR § 155.305(g)(1)).

## Essential Plan

NYSOH must generally determine an applicant eligible for the Essential Plan, a basic health plan, if the person is (1) a resident of New York State, (2) expects to have a household income between 138% and 200% of the applicable FPL or, in the case of an individual who is a lawfully present non-citizen who is ineligible for Medicaid or Child Health Plus as a result of their immigration status, has a household income that is between 0% and 200% of the FPL, (3) is not otherwise eligible for minimum essential coverage except through the individual market, (4) is 64 years old or younger, (5) is a citizen or a lawfully present non-citizen, and (6) is not incarcerated (see 42 CFR § 600.305, 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4), 45 CFR § 155.305(e), NY Social Services Law § 369-gg(3), 42 USC § 18051).

## <u>Medicaid</u>

Medicaid can be provided through NYSOH to adults who: (1) are age 19 or older and under age 65, (2) are not pregnant, (3) are not entitled to or enrolled for Medicare benefits under part A or B of title XVIII of the Act, (4) are not otherwise eligible for and enrolled for mandatory coverage under a State's Medicaid State plan in accordance with subpart B of this part, and (5) have a household modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) that is at or below 138% of the FPL for the applicable family size (42 CFR § 435.119(b), 42 CFR § 435.911(b)(1), 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4)), NY Social Services Law § 366(1)(b)).

# Legal Analysis

The only issue under review is whether NYSOH properly determined that you were eligible to receive up to \$175.00 per month in APTC, ineligible for costsharing reductions, ineligible for the Essential Plan, and ineligible for Medicaid, effective January 1, 2018.

The application submitted on December 2, 3017 indicated that you were filing your 2018 tax return as single and not claiming any dependents. The December 3, 3017 eligibility determination relied on this information.

As such, the December 3, 3017 eligibility determination was based on you being in a one-person household. However, you testified at the hearing that you will be claiming your youngest son as a dependent on your 2018 federal tax return. Therefore, you are in a two-person household.

Since the December 3, 2017 eligibility determination notice was based on incorrect information, it is RESCINDED and your case is being RETURNED to NYSOH to redetermine your eligibility for financial assistance based on a two-person household, with a household income of \$41,995.20 and living in Kings County, effective January 1, 2018.

## Decision

The December 3, 2017 eligibility determination notice is RESCINDED.

If your request is approved, another hearing will be scheduled for you. If your request is denied, NYSOH will tell you in writing. dismissed portion of your appeal within 30 days, your appeal will remain dismissed, and NYSOH will take no further action on your appeal.

Insofar as your case was decided, the Decision is final unless you submit an appeal request to the Federal Marketplace or bring a lawsuit under New York Civil Practice Law and Rules, Article 78.

You may bring a lawsuit on any Appeals Unit decision in New York State court in accordance with Article 78 of the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules. This must be done within four months of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision.

Additionally, Appeals Unit decisions on issues involving eligibility for qualified health plans, advance premium tax credits, and cost-sharing reductions may be appealed to the Federal Marketplace. This must be done within 30 days of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision (45 CFR § 155.520(c)).
