

Issues

The issue presented for review by the Appeals Unit of NY State of Health is:

Did NY State of Health (NYSOH) properly determine that you and your spouse were eligible to receive up to \$685.00 per month in advance payments of the premium tax credit (APTC), not eligible for cost-sharing reductions or the Essential Plan, effective February 1, 2018?

Procedural History

On December 22, 2017, an application for health insurance and financial assistance through NYSOH was submitted on behalf of you and your spouse.

On December 23, 2017, NYSOH issued an eligibility determination notice stating that you and your spouse were eligible to receive up to \$685.00 per month in APTC. That notice also stated that you were not eligible for cost sharing reductions, the Essential Plan, or Medicaid because your annual household income was over the allowable income limits for those programs.

On January 19, 2018, you spoke to NYSOH's Account Review Unit and appealed that eligibility determination notice insofar as you and your spouse were not eligible for an increased amount of financial assistance.

On March 15, 2018, you had a telephone hearing with a Hearing Officer from NYSOH's Appeals Unit. On that date you requested and were granted an adjournment.

On April 12, 2018, you had a telephone hearing with a Hearing Officer from NYSOH's Appeals Unit. The record was developed during the hearing and held open until April 20, 2018, to allow you time to submit supporting documents.

On April 18, 2018, NYSOH received your supporting documents by upload. The documents were incorporated into the record as Appellant's Exhibit #1 and the record was closed

Findings of Fact

A review of the record supports the following findings of fact:

- You testified that you expect to file your tax return for 2018 with a tax filing status of married filing jointly. You will claim no dependents on that tax return.
- 2) You are seeking insurance for you and your spouse.
- The application that was submitted on December 23, 2017 listed annual household income of \$45,926.65. You testified that this amount was incorrect.
- Your application states that you will not be taking any deductions on your 2018 tax return.
- 5) Your application states that you live in Westchester County.
- 6) On April 18, 2018 you uploaded to your NYSOH account the following: A Department of Labor Statement of unemployment benefit payments made to your spouse for 2017 in the amount of \$2,192.00, your spouse's W-2 for 2017 from in the amount of \$2,063.15, your spouse's W-2 for 2017 from in the amount of \$16,901.31, your pay stub with a pay date of December 15, 2017 from showing a year to date gross income of \$8,798.32, your pay stub with a pay date of December 17, 2017 from showing a year to date gross income of \$13,983.25.
- 7) Based on the documentation you provided, your household income is \$43,938.03.
- 8) You testified that you were not sure if your 2018 household income would be the same as your 2017 household income.
- You testified that you are seeking additional financial assistance through this appeal.

Conflicting evidence, if any, was considered and found to be less credible than the evidence noted above.

Applicable Law and Regulations

Advance Payments of Premium Tax Credit

APTC are generally available to a person who is eligible to enroll in a qualified health plan and (1) expects to have a household income between 138% and 400% of the applicable federal poverty level (FPL), (2) expects to file a tax return and claim a personal exemption deduction for a person who meets the eligibility requirements to enroll in a qualified health plan, and (3) is not otherwise eligible for minimum essential coverage except through the individual market (see 45 CFR § 155.305(f), 26 CFR § 1.36B-2, 42 CFR § 435.119(b), 42 CFR § 435.911(b)(1), 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4)).

People who use the APTC to help pay health insurance premiums must file a federal tax return and reconcile their expected income (stated on NYSOH application) with their actual income (stated on their federal income tax return). Those who take less tax credit in advance than they claim on the tax return may get the rest of it as an income tax refund or have their tax bill reduced. Those who take more tax credit in advance than they can claim on their tax return will owe the difference as additional income taxes (26 CFR § 1.36B-4).

Cost-Sharing Reductions

Cost-sharing reductions are available to a person who (1) is eligible to enroll in a qualified health plan through NYSOH, (2) meets the requirements to receive APTC, (3) is expected to have an annual household income that does not exceed 250% of the FPL for the first day of the open enrollment period of the benefit year for which coverage is requested, and (4) is enrolled in a silver-level qualified health plan (45 CFR § 155.300(a), 45 CFR § 155.305(g)(1)).

Essential Plan

NYSOH must generally determine an applicant eligible for the Essential Plan, a basic health plan, if the person is (1) a resident of New York State, (2) expects to have a household income between 138% and 200% of the applicable FPL or, in the case of an individual who is a lawfully present non-citizen who is ineligible for Medicaid or Child Health Plus as a result of their immigration status, has a household income that is between 0% and 200% of the FPL, (3) is not otherwise eligible for minimum essential coverage except through the individual market, (4) is 64 years old or younger, (5) is a citizen or a lawfully present non-citizen, and (6) is not incarcerated (see 42 CFR § 600.305, 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4), 45 CFR § 155.305(e), NY Social Services Law § 369-gg(3), 42 USC § 18051).

Medicaid


Medicaid can be provided through NYSOH to adults who: (1) are age 19 or older and under age 65, (2) are not pregnant, (3) are not entitled to or enrolled for Medicare benefits under part A or B of title XVIII of the Act, (4) are not otherwise eligible for and enrolled for mandatory coverage under a State's Medicaid State plan in accordance with subpart B of this part, and (5) have a household modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) that is at or below 138% of the FPL for the applicable family size (42 CFR § 435.119(b), 42 CFR § 435.911(b)(1), 42 CFR § 435.603(d)(4)), NY Social Services Law § 366(1)(b)).

Legal Analysis

The issue under review is whether NYSOH properly determined that you and your spouse were eligible to receive up to \$685.00 per month in APTC, not eligible for cost-sharing reductions and not eligible for the Essential Plan, effective February 1, 2018.

The application that was submitted on December 22, 2017 listed an annual household income of \$45,926.65 and the eligibility determination relied upon that information.

However, at the hearing, you testified that the household income used for the December 22, 2017 eligibility determination was incorrect.



You testified that you were not sure if your 2018 household income would be the same as your 2017 household income. In the absence of details regarding your 2018 income, your 2017 income will be used for this analysis. As such, based on the documentation you provided, your household income is \$43,938.03.

Since the December 23, 2017 eligibility determination notice was based on incorrect information, it is RESCINDED and your case is being RETURNED to NYSOH to recalculate you and your spouse's eligibility based on a two-person household, with a household income of \$43,938.03 and living in Westchester County, effective February 1, 2018.

How this Decision Affects Your Eligibility

Your case is being RETURNED to NYSOH to recalculate you and your spouse's eligibility based on a two-person household, with a household income of \$43,938.03 and living in Westchester County, effective February 1, 2018.

If You Disagree with this Decision (Appeal Rights)

If applicable, if you think a portion of your appeal should not be dismissed, you can ask us to vacate, or cancel, this dismissal. You must ask us in writing within 30 days after the date on this notice, showing good cause as to why the dismissal should be vacated. NYSOH's Appeals Unit will review your request. If your request is approved, another hearing will be scheduled for you. If your request is denied, NYSOH will tell you in writing. If you do not respond to the dismissed portion of your appeal within 30 days, your appeal will remain dismissed, and NYSOH will take no further action on your appeal.

Insofar as your case was decided, the Decision is final unless you submit an appeal request to the Federal Marketplace or bring a lawsuit under New York Civil Practice Law and Rules, Article 78.

You may bring a lawsuit on any Appeals Unit decision in New York State court in accordance with Article 78 of the New York Civil Practice Law and Rules. This must be done within four months of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision.

Additionally, Appeals Unit decisions on issues involving eligibility for qualified health plans, advance premium tax credits, and cost-sharing reductions may be appealed to the Federal Marketplace. This must be done within 30 days of the Decision Date, which appears on the first page of this Decision (45 CFR § 155.520(c)).
