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Coordination Strategy

In addition to agency participation in policy matters, NY-HX also has a Multi-faceted strategy for coordination with other agencies administering Insurance Affordability Programs and the SHOP with respect to IT:

- Direct Agency participation in system design
- NY-HX becomes the system of record for MAGI eligibility determinations for State Medical Assistance programs
- Cross agency data sharing MOUs are being established leveraging HIPAA, MITA and NIEM standards and interoperability at key points in the eligibility determination and enrollment activities
